Because of this disparity, national and local knowledge about forced displacement is underused.</p> <p>To help address this gap, IDRC is launching this call for proposals to localize and institutionalize research on forced displacement in the Global South by establishing research chairs on forced displacement at universities in South and Southeast Asia, and Central and South America. The aim is to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>empower institutions in these regions to define research agendas</li> <li>lead on practical, gender-transformative solutions that promote the social, economic, political, and health rights of forcibly displaced persons and host communities</li> <li>amplify the voices and perspectives of forcibly displaced persons and host communities in local, national, regional, and global arenas.</li> </ul> <p>The newly established research chairs will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>conduct research</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• mentor and supervise early-career scholars</li> <li>• work with relevant stakeholders to conduct outreach with communities, refugee-led initiatives, and civil society</li> <li>• advocate with policy stakeholders at the local, national, regional, and global levels to promote sustainable and workable solutions</li> </ul> <p>IDRC plans to support the establishment of up to four research chairs for a period of <b>four to five years</b>. Two chairs will be established at universities in South and Southeast Asia, and <b>two chairs at universities in Central and South America. He was born and raised in North Korea. At the age of 12, his father died of starvation and he was separated from his mother and sister.</p> <p>In 2006, Joseph escaped North Korea and went to China. In China, he connected with an international NGO called Liberty in North Korea. A year later, he left China for the United States and claimed refugee status under the North Korean Human Rights Act, signed by President George W. Bush in 2004.</p> <p>In 2013, Joseph delivered a TED Talk on the importance of hope, and published a memoir, "Under the Same Sky". Joseph interned as a research assistant at the Center for Strategic and International Studies (CSIS) Korea Chair. He is a former America Needs You fellow and Council of Korean Americans PSI intern.</p> <p>In 2019 he received his B.A. in political studies from Bard, and completed his Senior Project titled "Marketization in North Korea is Corrupting the Corrupted."</p>
