The foundation strongly encourages applications from scientists from underrepresented groups.</p> <p><u>Rationale:</u> The program is intended to support high-risk theoretical mathematics, physics and computer science projects of exceptional promise and scientific importance on a case-by-case basis.</p> <p><u>Funding and Allowable Expenses:</u> The Targeted Grant in MPS program provides funding for up to five years. The funding level and duration is flexible and should be appropriate based on the type of support requested in the proposal. There is no recommended or assumed funding level for this program.</p> <p><u>How to Apply:</u> Applicants must submit a Letter of Intent (LOI) through proposalCENTRAL. The deadline is rolling and an LOI can be submitted at any time.</p>

Descripción general	<p>Applications are sought from young, independent scholars who combine the highest level of research excellence with a demonstrated passion for delivering impact.</p> <p>The GYA is a global organisation that places a high value on its diversity. We encourage applications from all qualified candidates. All applicants receive consideration and will not be discriminated against with regard to race, colour, ethnicity, religion, creed, sex, marital status, ancestry, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, physical or mental disabilities, or other factors. We especially encourage women and applicants from different minority groups, and from diverse disciplines including the natural, physical and social sciences as well as the arts and humanities and people working in government, industry, and non-governmental sectors to apply.</p> <p>Research fields: The call is open to all scholars working in any research-based discipline, including the natural, physical and social sciences, as well as the arts and humanities.</p> <p>Excellence: Applicants must be able to demonstrate a high level of excellence in their discipline, ascertained by a proven track record and expected future achievements. Moreover, applicants must demonstrate a clear commitment to making a difference in society. PhD or equivalent is a requirement for applicants.</p> <p>Impact: The Global Young Academy is committed to a broad range of programmes around the world to support young scholars, promote science to a broad audience, engage in policy debate, and foster international and interdisciplinary collaboration. Applicants should provide evidence of interest or experience in one or more of these areas.</p> <p>Age/career point: Applicants should be in the early to middle years of their independent careers, i.e. approximately 7 years from PhD and aged 30-40. Applicants falling outside these ranges are still invited to send their applications with a justification for why they should be considered.</p>

	<p>Expectations: Each GYA member is expected to attend the GYA Annual General Meeting each year and is also expected to actively contribute to one or more of the organisation’s programmes, which include participation in policy development, promotion of National Young Academies, supporting science outreach and education at the national and international levels, and the young scientist ambassador programme. The GYA is an active organisation, and being a member requires a time commitment on each member’s part. Descripción general	<p>The purpose of this notice is to encourage collaborative research applications that take advantage of opportunities outside of the United States. Applications examining all areas of NIDA-supported research addressing the causes, consequences, treatment, recovery, and prevention of drug use, misuse, and addiction are encouraged. Projects may be conducted through newly formed or well-established partnerships between investigators in a U.S.-based institution and scientists working in another country. All NIH grant applications for research to be conducted outside the United States must establish that the proposal takes advantage of unique research opportunities in other countries, speeds scientific discovery, and advances U.S. health science.</p>

Substances that are of high priority:

- Cannabis, including commonly used forms of marijuana; flower, resin, extracts, purified cannabinoids, and especially cannabidiol and their use, routes of administration, consequences, impacts of changing laws and policies, and potential therapeutic benefits or harms
- Novel Psychoactive Substances (NPS), particularly synthetic opioids including fentanyl and its analogues, or other NPS entering wide use
- Opioids (prescription opioids, heroin, synthetic opioids, injection and non-injection use)
- Psychostimulants (cocaine, methamphetamine, and other amphetamine-type stimulants)
- Inhalants
- Tobacco and nicotine (including e-cigarettes and vaping).
