- To use the Coimbra Group Office electronic application process. Only one application per candidate will be accepted.

Descripción general	Instituto Serrapilheira and the International Centre for Theoretical Physics – South American Institute for Fundamental Research (ICTP – SAIFR) are jointly launching the Training Program in Quantitative Biology and Ecology. The goal of the program is to prepare future generations of Brazilian and Latin American researchers in the life sciences with a focus on the use of tools from mathematics, physics and computer science.

We seek students who wish to tackle major questions and develop cutting-edge research in biology and ecology. In the long-term, we aim to produce a generation of highly trained young Brazilian and Latin American scientists with quantitative skills who will study complex biological systems.

The program provides intensive training to students who are at the beginning of their academic careers. In addition to immersion in the main topics in biology and ecology through direct contact with scientists from international institutions at the forefront in their respective fields, participants will receive training in the use of quantitative methods for solving the most cutting-edge problems in the life sciences.

In light of today's necessary measures for dealing with the COVID-19 pandemic, the 2021 training program will be held online in a shorter one-month version. In July of this year, we will offer a four-week workshop for up to 50 participants.

Candidates must have graduated from an undergraduate program or be planning to do so by December 31, 2021, at an institution of higher education in Brazil or another Latin American country. Those who are already in a graduate program (either master's or doctoral) are also eligible. Students with an academic background in any field are welcome. Although there is no requirement to have research experience in the biological sciences, students must be proficient in English, and have previous knowledge of differential and integral calculus. (these requirements will be checked during the selection process). We seek ambitious students with quantitative skills who are willing to reach beyond traditional disciplinary boundaries and nurture a solid interest in the major questions in the life sciences.

<p>Descripción general</p>	<p>Vital Strategies' Healthy Food Policy Fellowship aims to combat an important barrier to addressing global obesity—a dearth of research expertise to guide national policies. The fellowship, funded by Bloomberg Philanthropies, supports Ph.D. candidates in Barbados, Brazil, Colombia, Jamaica, Mexico and South Africa who are committed to pursuing a field—such as health economics, nutrition epidemiology or health behavior—that will allow them to contribute to healthier food environments in their country of origin or residence through public policy.</p> <p>Strong preference is given to candidates who are committed to work in their country after they complete their program, and who demonstrate that they will apply their experience, skills and knowledge in disciplines, such as, health economics, nutrition epidemiology, marketing, or health behavior. Applicants who can establish their background or interest in contributing to research of national-level importance are encouraged to apply.</p> <p>In general, the Fellowship covers tuition, accommodation, health-insurance and study-related travel, if appropriate. Each Fellowship is dependent on the needs of the recipient, country of residence/school, and is bound by the funder's financial parameters.</p> <p>Selected Fellows must confirm that, in the two years prior to applying, they have had no affiliations with the sugary drinks, ultra-processed food or tobacco industries. Descripción general	<p>Online Event: As part of the CEU Speaker Series, Dr. Özge Yaka, Alexander von Humbolt PSI Fellow at the Centre for Citizenship, Social Pluralism and Religious Diversity, University of Potsdam, will speak on Frustration/Revelation – "Research as a Transformative Process: Methodology, Practice, and Positionality.</p> <p>Research can be characterized by long stretches of frustration and puzzlement, punctuated by occasional moments of revelation. This series focuses on exceptional scholars who will not deliver standard academic talks, but who will bring to life struggles faced when pursuing their research, how they came to study a specific topic, difficult choices made, failures, and then sometimes revelations - sudden or slowly accumulating - that have transformed how they view their research, their respective disciplines, and even the world at large.</p> <p>In the process, we also learn about academic disciplines and the kind of work scholars do in crafting their research. Conventional academic talks are about sharing the outcomes of research. This talk, however, will focus on the research itself, not as a vehicle to produce outcomes, but as a transformative process – which transforms both the conceptual frameworks and disciplinary identities of the researcher, and the way she positions herself within the inter-subjective practice of knowledge production.</p>
